Decision

1. The official, Mr Najeeb Chirakal, is found guilty of infringement of article 13 (General rules of conduct), article 15 (Loyalty), article 18 (Duty of disclosure), cooperation and reporting), article 19 (Conflicts of interest) article 20 (Offering and accepting gifts and other benefits), article 21 (Bribery and corruption), art. 41 (Obligation of the parties to collaborate) and art. 42 (General obligation to collaborate) of the FIFA Code of Ethics.
 2. The official, Mr Najeeb Chirakal, is hereby banned from taking part in any kind of football-related activity at national and international level (administrative, sports or any other) for life, in accordance with Article 6 lit. h) of the FIFA Code of Ethics in conjunction with Article 22 of the FIFA Disciplinary Code.
 3. The official, Mr Najeeb Chirakal shall pay costs of these proceedings in the amount of CHF 5,000 within 30 days of notification of the present decision.  4. The official, Mr Najeeb Chirakal, shall bear his own legal and other costs incurred in connection with the present proceedings.
 5. This decision is notified to Mr Najeeb Chirakal. A copy of the decision is sent to the AFC, and the Qatari Football Association (QFA). A copy of the decision is sent to the chief of the investigation, Ms Vanessa Allard.

Note relating to the terms of the decision:

Pursuant to art. 78 of the FIFA Code of Ethics, the Ethics Committee may decide not to communicate the grounds of a decision and instead communicate only the terms of the decision. The addressee of the decision has ten (10) days from receipt of the terms of the decision to request, in writing, the grounds of the decision. Failure to do so will result in the decision becoming final and binding. A request for the grounds of the decision does not affect the terms of the decision, which come into force as soon as they are communicated (art. 45 par. 1 of the FIFA Code of Ethics).

Note relating to the legal action:

Only the motivated decision can be appealed against to the FIFA Appeal Committee (Article 80 of the FIFA Code of Ethics in conjunction with Articles 119 et seq. of the FIFA Disciplinary Code).
