Suspension of the Trinidad and Tobago Football Association as of 24 September 2020 and until further notice

Dear Sir or Madam,

We inform you that, based on the decision taken by the Bureau of the FIFA Council on 24 September 2020, the Trinidad and Tobago Football Association (TTFA) has been suspended with immediate effect and until further notice, in accordance with article 16 of the FIFA Statutes.

Consequently, the TTFA loses all its membership rights, as defined in article 13 of the FIFA Statutes, with immediate effect and until further notice. TTFA representative and club teams are therefore no longer entitled to take part in international competitions until the suspension is lifted. This also means that, as of 24 September 2020, neither the TTFA nor any of its members or officials may benefit from any development programmes, courses or training from FIFA or the Confederation of North, Central America and Caribbean Association Football (Concacaf). Moreover, we remind you and your affiliates not to enter into any sporting contact with the TTFA and/or its teams while the association is suspended.

Finally, the Bureau of the FIFA Council or the FIFA Council may lift this suspension at any time before the next FIFA Congress takes place and we will inform you accordingly.
