

PROCEDURE

for obtaining a license to use radio frequencies or radio frequency channels during the period of preparation and staging of the 2018 FIFA World Cup Russia™

These guidelines apply to all radio electronic devices ('RED') used at venues of the FIFA World Cup Russia™ (FWC). An organization participating in the FWC appoints a representative responsible for applications for a license to use radio frequencies and radio frequency channels during the preparation and staging of FWC.

STEP 1 – OBTAINING ACCESS TO THE SPECTRUM ORDER PORTAL

The representative of the organization shall register at the Spectrum Order Portal (<https://spectrum.loc2018.com>). After checking the rights of participation in the FWC, the representative of the organization receives confirmation or denial to register with the Spectrum Order Portal to the e-mail address specified at registration.

STEP 2 – PREPARING A RADIO FREQUENCY APPLICATION

User shall log into the Spectrum Order Portal using personal login name and password, fill in, save and submit an application for a license to use radio frequencies or radio frequency channels (hereinafter - 'Licence'). Thereafter the regulator in the field of communication of the Russian Federation will process it. Depending on the review result, the status of the application is updated in the personal account of the Spectrum Order Portal. The processing time of the application is up to 30 days.

STEP 3 – PREPARING REDs FOR USE DURING

After receiving the Licence review RED user shall study the terms of use of radio frequencies and radio frequency channels outlined in the Licence and, prior to arriving at the FWC venue, configure REDs as required by the Licence.

STEP 4 – RECEIVING A SPECIAL TAG

Before using REDs the user must pass the test for compliance with the parameters specified in the Licence at the Test and Tag Centre – [Spectrum Office \(the addresses and working hours of Test and Tag Centres will be published on the Portal\)](#), receive and stick the special tag on the RED.

The special tag serves as a permit to use REDs at the Stadiums and IBC.

Special tag sample for use at the Stadium:



Bringing RED with NO special tag to the Stadium and IBC is strictly prohibited.

**List of the types of radio electronic devices
permitted to use at FWC venues without obtaining a license to use radio frequencies
or radio frequency channels and which do not require tagging**

Item No.	Type of RED
1.	Subscriber devices (USB modems) for wireless access based on GSM, IMT-MC, UMTS, Wi-Fi, WiMax, LTE radio technologies, including those built-in or incorporated into other devices.
2.	Subscriber cellular telephones of the GSM, IMT-MC, UMTS, LTE standards, including those embedded or incorporated into other devices.
3.	INMARSAT, Globalstar, Thuraya, or Iridium ground terminals of mobile satellite communication.
4.	Remote control key fobs of radio controlled car alarms.
5.	Bluetooth radioelectronic devices, including those embedded or incorporated into other devices.
6.	Radioelectronic devices for detecting and rescuing victims of natural disasters.
7.	End user receiving devices of GPS/Glonass satellite navigation systems, including those embedded or incorporated into other devices.
8.	Medical implants and other medical devices implanted into the human body.
9.	Radio hearing aids for persons with hearing impairments.
